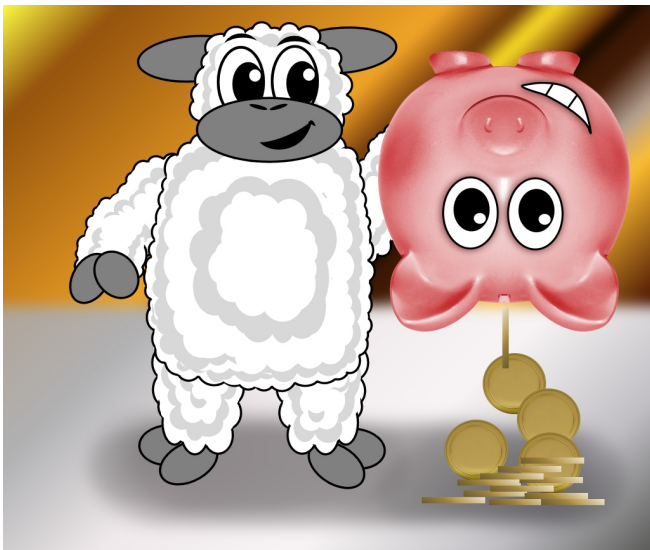


Sharing
